"In am a FAITHFUL employee who will be fully INTEGRATED in five years' time, and a VALUABLE member of the organization who adds value to the team. I will be EXPERIENCED across different departments and working toward a promotion."

INTERVIEW QUESTION #6 – WHY DO YOU WANT TO LEAVE YOUR JOB?

The word to remember when answering this next tough interview question is: CAN.

CAN stands for:

- CHAPTER
- ACHIEVED
- NEXT

"I want to leave my job because I am ready for the next CHAPTER of my career. I have ACHIEVED many great things with my team and loved every minute, However, I am now ready for the NEXT opportunity where my skills and knowledge will be pushed even further and I hope it is with your company in this role."

INTERVIEW QUESTION #7 – WHY DO YOU WANT TO WORK HERE?

The word to remember when answering this next tough interview question is: RICH.

You can remember this word because hopefully, you'll become RICH when you work for their company!

RICH stands for:

- RESEARCH
- IMPRESSIVE
- COLLABORATE
- HIGH QUALITY

"I want to work here because my RESEARCH tells you are a forward-thinking company with an IMPRESSIVE track record. I want to work here because I will get to

COLLABORATE on exiting projects that deliver HIGH QUALTY products and services to customers."
